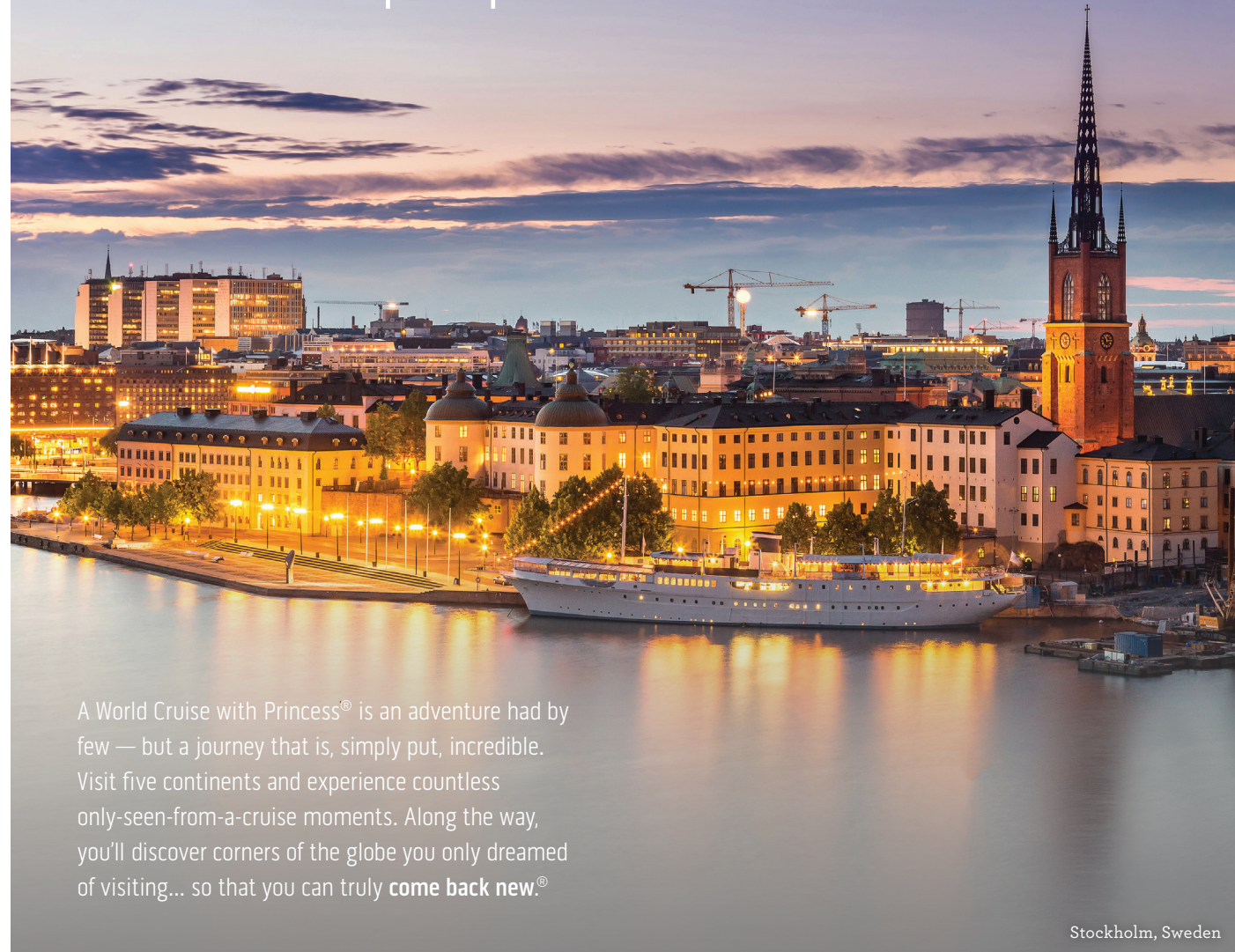

14 May | Sydney

Step onboard Sea Princess and bid farewell to Sydney as you prepare to be mesmerised by a world of destinations.

16 May | Brisbane

The gateway to some of Queensland’s greatest attractions, including theme parks, wildlife parks and the iconic Gold Coast, Brisbane is a favourite among visitors. This riverside city boasts a vibrant cultural scene and stunning parklands.

23 May | Komodo Island, Indonesia

Home to over 4000 komodo dragons, Komodo Island is a thriving national park. Cast your gaze upon the red, rusty hills, mangrove forests and coral reefs set to impress the most experienced divers.

26 May | Singapore

The commercial centre of South East Asia, Singapore is a lively mix of ethnicities, traditions and modern luxury. Shop up a storm, take in the sights and don’t forget to sample the famous Singapore chilli crab.

30 May | Colombo, Sri Lanka

Delve into the stunning beauty of Sri Lanka’s exotic capital, Colombo. Explore the Buddhist temples, fine beaches, unique wildlife and UNESCO World Heritage sites including the last Sinhalese kingdom at Kandy.

3 Jun | Muscat, Oman (Mina Qaboos)

Oman’s capital, Muscat is a mix of old and new. Marvel at the sixteenth century Portuguese ports overlooking the harbour, or take in the fascinating traditional architecture interwoven with modern designs.

4 - 5 Jun | Dubai, UAE

There’s so much to do in spellbinding Dubai. Wander the aromatic and bustling souk (market); see the Burj Khalifa, the tallest building in the world; or visit the awe-inspiring Jumeirah Mosque.



12 Jun | Aqaba, Jordan (for Petra)

Explore the ancient world with an inspiring visit to the lost city of Petra, featured in films such as Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade. Venture into the surrounding desert to see Wadi Rum, ‘the valley of the moon’.

13 - 14 Jun | Suez Canal Transit (Scenic Cruising)

A journey paved by many a merchant, take in the breathtaking desert views as you enjoy a scenic transit from the Red Sea to the Mediterranean Sea.

17 Jun | Valletta, Malta

Malta’s capital and a World Heritage site is an eclectic blend of Baroque architecture, the majestic St. John’s Co-Cathedral, quaint cafes and wine bars.

19 Jun | Barcelona, Spain

The city that nurtured the likes of Picasso, Dali, and Miro, Barcelona is one of Europe’s greatest treasures. Marvel at the spires of Gaudi’s Basilica La Sagrada Familia or visit the former Olympic Ring on the hill of Montjuic.

21 Jun | Seville, Spain (Cádiz)

This ancient port city, founded in 1100 BC, is one of Europe’s oldest. Almost entirely surrounded by water, the town is a maze of winding streets filled with taverns serving up tempting tapas and spectacular seafood.

25 Jun | Amsterdam, Netherlands

Discover Amsterdam’s architectural wonders, cultural highlights and profound history. The picture-perfect canals showcase the city’s most elegant mansions, churches, and warehouses from Holland’s Golden Age.

27 Jun | Berlin, Germany (Warnemünde)

Warnemünde, once a charming small fishermen’s village, kept its old charm down to the present day. Stroll along the Old Stream the former approach to the harbor or visit the German capital of Berlin and the city’s highlights.

29 Jun | Riga, Latvia

Capital of Latvia and the largest city of the Baltic Republics, Riga has long been a center of commerce and culture. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Old Town of Riga was founded in the early 13th century and is a wonderland of medieval culture and Art Nouveau architecture, from Riga Castle to the Dome Cathedral.

30 Jun | Tallinn, Estonia

A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Toompea or “Upper Town” is the home of some of Tallinn’s oldest architectural wonders and home to Palace Square.

1 Jul | Helsinki, Finland

Hailed as the “Daughter of the Baltic,” Finland’s capital is a city of graceful neoclassical buildings, striking modern architecture and spacious boulevards dotted with squares and parks.

2 - 3 Jul | St. Petersburg, Russia

Russia’s “Window on the West,” St. Petersburg remains one of the world’s most beautiful metropolises. St. Petersburg has also been the cultural soul of Russia, a repository of priceless art and a home to poets, musicians and composers ranging from Pushkin to Shostakovich.

5 Jul | Stockholm, Sweden

Often described as the “Capital of Scandinavia,” and with an history stretching over seven centuries, Stockholm is not just a beautiful city but also Sweden’s center of art and culture.

7 Jul | Copenhagen, Denmark

Copenhagen deserves its accolade as the Venice of the North. Founded on a series of islands and islets, the city today is laced with graceful canals and boasts some of the most delightful architecture in Northern Europe.

9 Jul | London, Great Britain (Dover)

The White Cliffs of Dover signal your arrival at London’s doorstep. Explore the notorious Tower of London, visit Windsor Castle or head to Kent’s green countryside, dotted with medieval towns and castles.

10 Jul | Portland, Great Britain (for Stonehenge)

Portland Harbour is one of the largest man-made harbours in the world. UNESCO has designated the stretch between Dorset and Devon English Channel shore as a World Heritage site. Visit the magical ancient site of Stonehenge. Tour the stunning coastline. Head to Old Harry Rocks and discover the geology and history going back to when William the Conqueror ruled this land.

11 Jul | Cork, Ireland (Cobh for Blarney Castle)

Australia Day Celebration and Welcome by the city of Cobh, Ireland, a unique Princess World Cruise Tradition. Cork is your gateway to romantic Ireland. Stroll down narrow country lanes or see the Lakes of Killarney. The intrepid visitor may scale the narrow passages of Blarney Castle to kiss the Blarney Stone.

14 Jul | Reykjavik, Iceland

From volcanoes to glaciers, thermal springs to icy rivers, Reykjavik is your gateway to Iceland’s contrasting wonders, including the famous Blue Lagoon, a stunning outdoor geothermal spa and Strokkur, a geyser that hurls boiling water up to 20 metres skyward.

18 Jul | St. John’s, Canada

As Canada’s most easterly province, the island of Newfoundland is situated on the North Atlantic, with St. John’s as its provincial capital. Its history and cultural spirit show strong Irish and Scottish influences evident in its pubs and music. The surrounding land is rugged, with a dramatic coastline heavily indented with bays and inlets, which give way to an interior terrain of wild mountains, hills, lakes and rivers.

21 - 22 Jul | New York, USA

You’ll have plenty of time to wander the concrete catwalks and see all the sights of ‘New York New York’ with an overnight stay in The Big Apple. Central Park, Times Square, the Statue of Liberty...the list goes on.

24 Jul | Charleston, USA

Escape to historic Charleston, where Southern charm’s a-plenty. You’ll feel like you’ve stepped back in time as you navigate cobblestone streets, horse-drawn carriages and antebellum architecture at every turn.

28 Jul | Willemstad, Curaçao

This charming capital city is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Boasting a rich and diverse history and culture, its traditional Dutch architecture has been infused with the color and spirit of the Caribbean.

30 Jul | Panama Canal (Full Day Transit)

Experience this colossal wonder as you transit between two oceans. Take in the sights as you dine on authentic Panamanian cuisine and let our expert narration guide you as the ship passes through the locks.

1 Aug | Puntarenas, Costa Rica

Visit Costa Rica’s vibrant capital city, home of to the Gold Museum, the spectacular Metropolitan Cathedral, the historic National Museum and the National Theater, considered to be the country’s most beautiful building.

3 Aug | Quito, Ecuador (Manta)

Manta is your gateway to Ecuador and its capital, Quito. Ecuador’s well-preserved capital and one of the world’s first UNESCO World Heritage Sites, Quito boasts a wealth of South American history as well as phenomenal views of the Andes.

5 Aug | Salaverry, Peru

The port city of Salaverry is the gateway to Trujillo, Peru’s second-largest city. Whether stepping back into the past or discovering a new seafood dish, riding the waves at Huanchaco Beach or shopping for authentic leather goods and mementos from artisan craftsmen, or walking along the world’s longest mosaic depicting the history of northern Peru, a visit to Trujillo is a treasure trove of cultural delights.

6 Aug | Lima, Peru (Callao)

Discover thousands of Peru’s most treasured gold, silver and copper artifacts, from pre-Inca jewelry to military objects and tools, as well as historic weaponry. Despite the verdict of the great conquistador, Lima became the center of imperial Spanish power, a “City of Kings”. From Lima you can take an excursion to Machu Picchu. Visit princess.com

12 Aug | Easter Island, Chile

Wander amongst the mysterious monoliths on Easter Island on this truly other-worldly experience. Sea Princess anchors off shore, so you have plenty of time to uncover the ancient secrets of this mythical hot spot.

15 Aug | Pitcairn Island, British Overseas Territory (Scenic Cruising)

This small, isolated island located halfway between New Zealand and the Americas is home to less than sixty inhabitants. Enjoy a scenic cruise around this humble island as our onboard guide highlights points of interest.

18 Aug | Tahiti, French Polynesia (Papeete)

singapore

The commercial centre of Southeast Asia, this island city-state of four million people is a metropolis of modern high-rise buildings, Chinese shophouses with red-tiled roofs, sturdy Victorian buildings and Buddhist temples. Founded in 1819 by Sir Stamford Raffles of the fabled East India Company, the city is a melting pot of people and cultures.



komodo island

Komodo Island is the largest island in Komodo National Park and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Komodo lizards’ existence was discovered about 100 years ago when Dutch sailors encountered the creatures for the first time. Reaching 10 feet in length and weighing over 300 pounds, Komodo dragons are the world’s largest and heaviest lizards.



colombo

Once known as Ceylon, the Sri Lankan capital of Colombo has a landscape that varies widely across the island. The bustling city streets in one area will guide you to a magnificent beach, and even to a tropical rainforest in others.



valletta, malta

Named the European City of Culture for 2018, the city of Valletta, Malta, has one of the most concentrated historic areas in the world. Valletta is a popular port of call for cruises in Europe and a must-visit locale for anyone interested in history or culture.



cork

Cork is your gateway to romantic Ireland. Stroll down narrow country lanes or see the Lakes of Killarney. The region around Cork is also home to one of the densest concentration of prehistoric monuments in Western Europe.



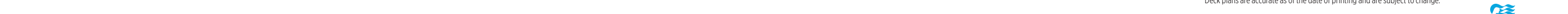
